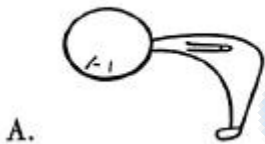

Have you ever bought Genki Forest (元气森林) sparkling water because it's advertised as "sugar – free"? The company recently gized (道歉) for the wrong advertisement.

The company said the drinks are "sucrose – free"(零蔗糖), but this is not the same as "sugar-free". Now the company has changed the words "sugar-free" to "low sugar" on the bottles.

In fact, there are many kinds of sugar. Sucrose is just one of them. Other kinds of sugar, such as fructose(果糖) and sugar alcohol (糖醇), are still in Genki Forest drinks. These types of sugar are used as sweeteners (甜味剂). They offer little energy, but a bit of them can make drinks taste sweet. That's why diet drinks like Genki Forest are popular among people who want to lose weight. They believe that they can not only enjoy sweet drinks, but also don't take in too much sugar.

However, studies find that the sweeteners might make people eat more. When you eat sweet-

tasting things, your brain knows it. Then your brain tells your body to prepare itself to take in energy. But since the diet soft drink has little energy, the brain will not receive what it is expecting. At this time, you will feel hungry and start getting energy by eating more food.

According to China Daily, drinking too many diet drinks might lead to obesity(肥胖) and type 2 diabetes(糖尿病). It's time for you to think twice about the diet drinks.

Not all heroes wear capes(披风). In fact, some walk around the streets to provide free treatment for homeless people's pets. Meet Dr Kwane Stewart, a 50-year-old vet(兽医)from California, the US.

Stewart always takes his bag with him wherever he goes. In this way, he can make a stop when he meets an animal in need or a homeless person with a pet. He has helped cure over 400 animals in the course of his 9-year service in the street. "About 25% of the homeless here own a pet," Stewart said. "A quick check up, maybe some medicine or food...it isn't a lot but sometimes giving a little can make all the difference."

Words about his work to help animals spread, and he ended up getting his own reality TV show(真人电视节目) --- "The Street Vet". It follows him to cities in California, where he offers free check for the pets he sees in the streets.

Though many of his four-legged patients can easily be treated, Stewart does face some difficulties: some of the pets need treatment that can be very expensive. That is why Stewart now runs a GoFundMe page. "All donations will surely make a difference in the pets' and their owners' lives," Stewart writes on the page. He now has raised over ninety thousand dollars.

"Working on the streets, I've experienced some of the true stories of love and hope," says Stewart, who dreams of bringing more vets into the streets to help pets.
